S.A.F.E.R. Junior Facilitator Job Description:

Students Advocating For Equality in Relationships (*S.A.F.E.R.*) is an extension of the Domestic Violence Education and Prevention (*D.V.E.P.*) program, at My Sisters' Place. *SAFER* is a year round teen volunteer program. We offer teens an opportunity to earn community service hours by participating in: trainings, activities, facilitating events, co-facilitate presentations, community outreach, and program development and planning. *SAFER* empowers teens to become advocates among their peers and in their communities.

Junior Facilitator Responsibilities Include (but are not limited to):

- Completion of volunteer orientation and trainings
- Attendance and participation in SAFER events
- Development of SAFER program
- Other tasks as assigned to General Volunteers
