### **S.A.F.E.R. General Volunteer Job Description:**

Students Advocating For Equality in Relationships (*S.A.F.E.R.*) is an extension of the Domestic Violence Education and Prevention (*D.V.E.P.*) program, at My Sisters' Place. *SAFER* is a year round teen volunteer program. We offer teens an opportunity to earn community service hours by participating in: trainings, activities, facilitating events, community outreach, and program development and planning. *SAFER* empowers teens to become advocates among their peers and in their communities.

### **Volunteer Responsibilities Include (but are not limited to):**

- Completion of volunteer orientation and trainings
- Attendance and participation in SAFER events
- Development of SAFER program
- Compiling and updating publications, outreach and training materials
- Research and maintaining program database
- Photocopying materials, compiling mailings, and answering phones
- Other tasks as assigned

- Safety Planning 101

**Eligibility Requirements:** Teens between the ages of 14-18 years who reside in Westchester County or are enrolled in a Westchester County high school are eligible to apply
